## Student Contract Grades 5-12

I understand that my school wants to help me pursue excellence in all areas of my life. The staff and administration of Excel Christian School will have expectations of me that follow godly principles and therefore may differ from expectations that the world considers acceptable. I recognize that if I want to achieve spiritual, moral, relational and academic excellence, I will need to commit to the following:

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. I will read the parent/student handbook and will ask questions if I read something that I do not understand.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. I will follow the rules and guidelines as they are explained in the handbook. This includes the rules about attendance, dress code and classroom behavior.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. I will respect other students, their property and the school's property. I will always show respect to the staff and faculty of Excel, even when we disagree.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. I will honor and obey all laws regarding the use of alcohol, tobacco and drugs. As a student of Excel, I recognize that I represent my school even when I'm not at school, and therefore am expected to always demonstrate a Christian lifestyle.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. I will honor God by keeping His command to "avoid sexual immorality...each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable." (II Thessalonians 4:3-4)
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. I will fulfill all requirements for my Christian Studies class, or authorized home school Christian Studies curriculum, recognizing that the goal of that class is to help me conform to the image of Christ in all areas of my life.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. I understand that these commitments are made from my willingness to allow God to impact my life through Excel Christian School and that I am expected to conform to God's character and will. If the staff and administration feel that I am not honoring these commitments, I understand that they will confront me in a Christ-like manner. I give permission to be counseled by the school counselor or administration if I, the administration, or my parents request it.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. I commit, as an imitator of Christ, to walk in righteousness and integrity. I will not:
  - Deliberately take information from another source and claim it as my own, or fail to give the source credit.
  - Let my parents or my friends do my homework for me.
  - Copy the school work of others.
  - Hack into a teacher's files.
  - Share test answers with someone who hasn't yet taken the test.
  - Use cell phones to get answers to a test or an assignment.
  - Stay home from school to avoid a due date on an assignment that I haven't completed.
  - Do anything deceitful and dishonest regarding school work.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. I understand that if I fail to honor these commitments and then also fail to demonstrate a heart of repentance, I may be asked to leave Excel Christian School.
