Parent Pledge

The relationship between Excel Christian School and the parents of our students is a vital element of our vision for education. Therefore, we ask that you read our expectations of you as a parent, and then pledge your support in the following areas:

Initial

- _____ 1. I pledge to honor my financial commitment to Excel Christian School, understanding that my tuition payments are a crucial part of the school's budget. If I withdraw my child before the end of the year, I understand that no records will be released until any amounts due have been paid in full. This includes any lost textbook fees and unfulfilled volunteer hours.
- _____ 2. I pledge to be supportive of the fund-raising efforts of Excel Christian School, participating in any way I am able, in order to keep tuition costs low. I pledge to support the total school program by giving permission for my child to take part in school-sponsored activities, including those events for which school is released early in order to allow more time for the event.
- _____ 3. I pledge to support the members of the Excel Christian School administration, faculty, staff, and Board of Directors. In case of conflict, I pledge to resolve the conflict by following the Conflict Resolution procedures in the Student Handbook, which are based on the biblical principles taught in Matthew 18.
- _____ 4. I pledge to encourage my child to uphold the conduct standards outlined in the Student Handbook, including not using alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or engaging in any acts of immorality. This student code of conduct is in effect the entire time any student is enrolled as an Excel student, on campus and off. I understand that my child may be asked to leave Excel if he or she chooses not to adhere to this code of conduct.
- _____ 5. I pledge that I will support Excel Christian School in their efforts to teach the Statement of Faith. I will support and encourage Excel as they strive to teach my child how to apply biblical principles to everyday living.
- _____ 6. I pledge to make sure my child arrives at school on time; I pledge to uphold the attendance policy, understanding that students may not pass a class unless they attend the prescribed number of days.

Volunteer Program

- _____ 7. I pledge to volunteer a minimum of 25 hours per academic year to Excel Christian School. I can earn hours by volunteering at the school, chaperoning special events and/or field trips, helping with building maintenance or janitorial work, being involved with fundraising events, etc. I will pay attention to announcements regarding volunteer opportunities, understanding that I will be billed \$10 per volunteer hour for every unfulfilled hour at the end of the year. I also understand that I can pre-pay a \$250 opt-out fee if I choose not to volunteer.
